Monologue (If known) _____

Scholarships in the amounts of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) will be awarded to the winning male and female contestants. These scholarships are to be used for college, performing arts high schools or performing arts camps. The scholarship checks will be issued to recipients or their chosen institutions upon proof of enrollment. All scholarship monies will be held in trust until such time. A voucher will be issued at the time of winning.

Rules:

1. Students must be High School Grade levels 9-12
2. Students must select, memorize, and perform a monologue from a Shakespeare Play.
3. The monologue must not exceed 20 lines.
4. Elaborate costumes should not be worn by participants, simple poets shirt, skirt or pants and appropriate footwear are best.
5. Students must register before the deadline to Participate. No walk- up registration.
6. The competition will be adjudicated by a panel of no less than three judges.
7. Monologue introductions should include: Actor's name, Character's name, title, act, scene
8. Actors should exhibit a spirit of cooperation and helpfulness towards others.
9. Disruptive or rude performers and observers will be asked to leave.
10. Actors will be evaluated based on physical choices, vocal variety, use of levels, and understanding of the characterization process of Shakespeare's characters.
11. Judges will provide constructive feedback on request.
12. Student **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.

Causes for Expulsion – BBCRF/BBVRS, INC management and security have final say in these matters.

Anyone who is obviously drunk or under the influence of drugs.

1. Anyone handling or brandishing a weapon in a manner deemed dangerous by the BBCRF AND BBVRS, INC. management or security.
2. Anyone SMOKING, unless in designated smoking area's outside the faire gates A & B.
3. Anyone selling, distributing or wearing illegal goods or drug related items or items that imply drug use. This is a zero tolerance policy.
4. According to the weapon laws, any vendor selling weapons to minors.
5. Anyone passing the hat without the appropriate license.
6. Anyone stealing.
7. Anyone caught entering or leaving a booth or campsite after hours without permission.
8. Anyone behaving improperly with a minor. Minors are not allowed in booth back areas, guild or entertainment encampments except accompanied by an adult
9. Anyone arguing with the management or security.
10. Anyone NOT complying with Fire Dept or City rule.

Adults responsible for minors will be expelled with any minor in violation of the rules.

I have read all **Terms and Conditions** for participants and I agree to comply with them. I understand that failure to do so may result in my expulsion from the faire without chance to compete and I may be barred from future BBCRF/BBVRS, Inc events. ***** Faire will be held rain or shine*****

I assume ALL and any responsibility for myself and my Student and will in no way hold the BBCRF and the BBVRS, Inc. responsible for theft, damage to, or loss of any items having to do in any way with our participation, personal belongings, my person in general, or any persons belonging or persons in general in our group or in the group encampment at any time during all hours before, during, and after the official hours of the faire, or during set-up or take-down of the faire.

I hereby authorize the BBCRF/BBVRS, Inc. to use any and all audio and/or visual recording depicting my voice or person in period character or costume for promotional publication. This authorization includes but is not limited to photographs, audio tapes, video tape, slides and other recordings
